Penelope Ingram is a dynamic pop and R&B vocalist whose soulful tone and storytelling ability have earned her recognition as a standout young performer. With more than eight years of live experience, she has built a reputation for connecting deeply with audiences through authentic emotion and a commanding stage presence.

Currently a senior at Interlochen Arts Academy, Penelope studies popular music performance and songwriting while maintaining a 4.0 GPA. She has been featured as lead vocalist in major academy productions including New Beginnings and Collage and, performing works by artists such as Stevie Wonder and H.E.R. Guided by vocal coaches and instructors, including Dr. Carter Smith and Joshua Davis, and Master Class training from top singers like Grammy-nominated Ruby Amanfu and others, she continues to refine her vocal range, technique, and creative artistry while writing original material that blends pop, soul, and contemporary R&B influences.

Beyond the stage, Penelope uses her voice to advocate for vulnerable and marginalized populations. She recently founded the Big Dreamers Project, an advocacy club that raises awareness of animal cruelty and provides support to animal rescue and welfare organizations. Her leadership and training at Interlochen, along with summer intensives at the University of Miami's Frost School of Music and Belmont University, have shaped her into a thoughtful, collaborative artist ready to take on the next challenge. As she looks toward college, Penelope is eager to grow into a musician who can create, perform, and lead with purpose and authenticity, on and off the stage.
